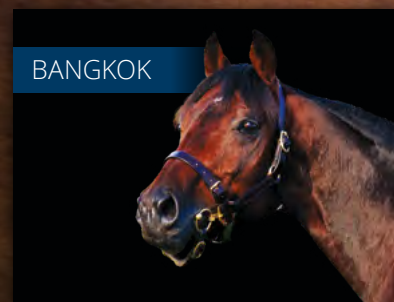

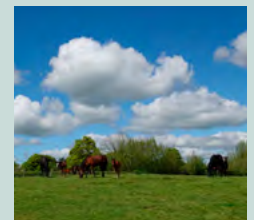
**Chapel Stud is set in the classical landscape of the Malvern Hills, close to the River Teme. Based on over 70 acres of established prime pasture land, the original dairy farm has been transformed into a modern thoroughbred stud since it was purchased in 2019.**

The barns were converted into 50 stables along with new stallion boxes and a covering shed. A new barn for wintering the youngstock was also constructed and two horse walkers installed.

In addition, the stud has access to a further 40 acres of grazing land surrounding the stud.

Trainers themselves are recognising that demand is shifting – buyers now want horses that can stay, not just sprint and as a C.T, he can do just that.

**Eldar Eldarov**, our Classic-winning Champion Stayer, joins the line-up as a stallion of real quality and depth. He's bred in the purple, was tough and sound throughout a top-level career, and offers a rare blend of durability and brilliance.

He's exactly the kind of horse we all should be breeding from – correct, straightforward and talented. We are looking forward to welcoming his first foals in 2026.

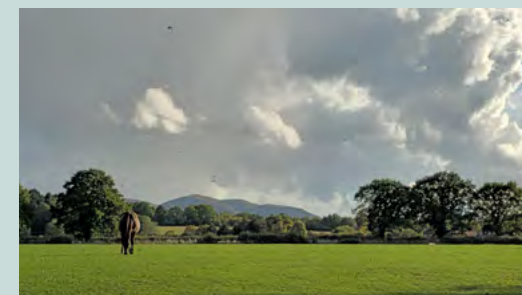
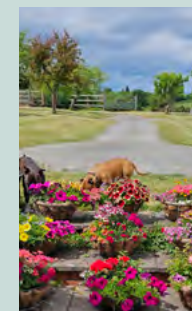
